COURSE AIMS

The course aims at providing a first introduction to food law through the comparative analysis of some selected topics.

COURSE CONTENT

The readings will be specified at the beginning of the course.

TEACHING METHOD

The teaching will consist in lectures on the topics part of the program, supported by the use of slides and court decisions. Students will be divided in groups and will have to develop a group project.

ASSESSMENT METHOD

The final grade will be the result of:

- 1) An intermediate written test (1/3) on the first half of the program;
- 2) A final written examination (1/3) on the second half;
- 3) The evaluation of a group project (1/3).
